Dear Friend!


The election is over and has been certified by King County Elections. About half of our candidates won their races for various non-partisan positions. Conservative members of city councils, school boards, and hospital boards are in short supply, yet almost half of our backed candidates were able to maintain their office or be elected to an open seat. Thank you to everyone who ran for election! Our communities will be better served if more individuals like those who ran this year stepped up.

What was surprising to me was that even with same day voter registration, not even half of our state's voters bothered to turn in a ballot. Statewide it was 45% and in King County 48% voted. Surprisingly, about half of the Republican voters in King County were among those who didn't vote. Consider the number of city council races that would have had different results if more conservative voters had engaged in their civic duty. This is why we must turn out our conservative friends and neighbors. Together we can change the fate of our great County.

On election night, KCGOP held an election night party. It was an opportunity for those who attended to "talk politics" without being shouted down by someone holding a different opinion. The First Amendment was being honored that night. Some of our candidates also attended and had a chance to share about their campaign experiences.

Next year we will be putting our efforts into getting Republicans who support our conservative values elected to office. It will require hard work and financial resources. 2020 is going to be big and we are going to need all of you helping in various capacities.
